## MEMORANDUM

**TO:** St. Cloud Regional Airport Users  
**FROM:** Bill Towle, Airport Director  
**SUBJECT:** Aircraft Fueling Near Hangars

---

Based upon the International Fire Code, Chapter 11, Aviation Facilities, the Fixed Base Operator – St. Cloud Aviation – will no longer be able to fuel aircraft inside or partially inside hangars.

This means that if a based aircraft needs fuel, the entire aircraft must be pulled out of the hangar and parked at least 25 feet away before it can be fueled.

In the past, St. Cloud Aviation has fueled aircraft while they were partially in the hangar, making it easier to push it back once the fueling was complete. Based upon the International Fire Code, this will no longer be allowed.

If you require fuel, please contact the FBO at 320.253.1500 to coordinate the timing so the FBO does not have to pull the aircraft out and put it back, making extra work.
